Committee Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Basket Raffle Fundraiser: Daisha provided an update. We have two days left to gather donations for the basket. Daisha posted a reminder on Facebook and will send an e-mail reminder again. Volunteer spot will go out this weekend for this and family fun night.
